The story of "WaschWelt" began in 1961 with the founding of Südramol, a wholesale company specializing in lubricants and fuels. In 1968, the company built the first large-scale gas station with an integrated car wash in Neu-Ulm – a pioneering facility for the region.

Following the motto "Car washing in a new dimension," WaschWelt Süd GmbH has been developing, implementing, and operating innovative and eco-friendly car wash facilities at a high technical standard since 2010.

Südramol GmbH sought a distinctive, clear, and concise brand identity for its new car wash facilities. This vision was realized through a streamlined and refreshed color palette and typography, the creation of a bold yet intuitive signage system, and its consistent application across all business materials, media, and communication tools.

The dynamic imagery focuses not on the automobile itself but on the driving experience and the emotions associated with it, aiming to engage and captivate the next generation of motorists.

The company's experiences are promoted through a vibrant and unconventional visual identity. Each subbrand has its own nuanced color scheme to enhance individual recognition, yet all remain visually connected under the umbrella brand.

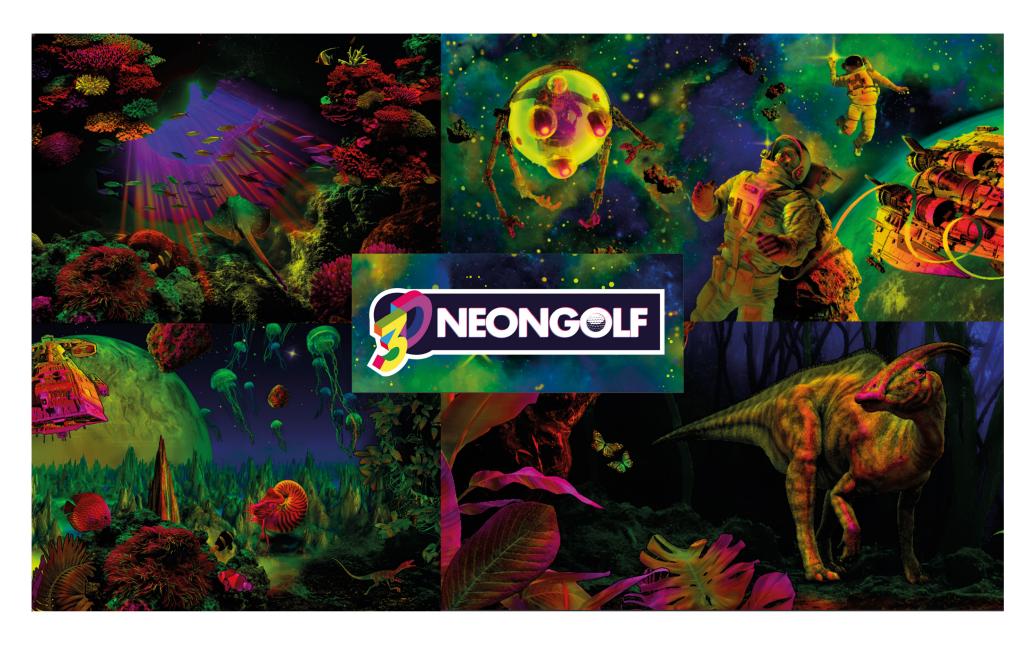
The scope of business materials is impressively extensive, ranging from classic items like business cards, letterheads, and office stamps to flags, banners, team apparel, water bottles, vehicle decals, stickers, and both digital and analog signage systems at the venues, as well as façade and hall designs in the defined style.

Additionally, in Munich, the neon golf walls were developed as cohesive themed areas, designed, colored, and printed digitally to create a consistent and immersive experience.

Following its comprehensive renovation and the completion of the 1968 facility in the summer of 2021, the Kutzenhausen outdoor pool now boasts a beautiful, modern appearance. It has become a vibrant summer gathering place for nearby communities, appealing to both young and old alike with its welcoming, family-friendly atmosphere.

The municipality used the pool's renovation as an opportunity to refresh its visual identity. The goal was to create a design that would resonate with all generations who visit the pool, recognizing its deep emotional significance for many long-time patrons, as revealed by a pre-renovation survey.

The resulting brand pays homage to design aesthetics from the 1960s, reimagined in a contemporary layout. It aims to engage all age groups while giving the pool a distinctive and unique identity. A graphical signage system inspired by the pool's new modern architecture, along with a range of branded merchandise including towels, pool slippers, and apparel, further enhances the fresh, high-quality look.

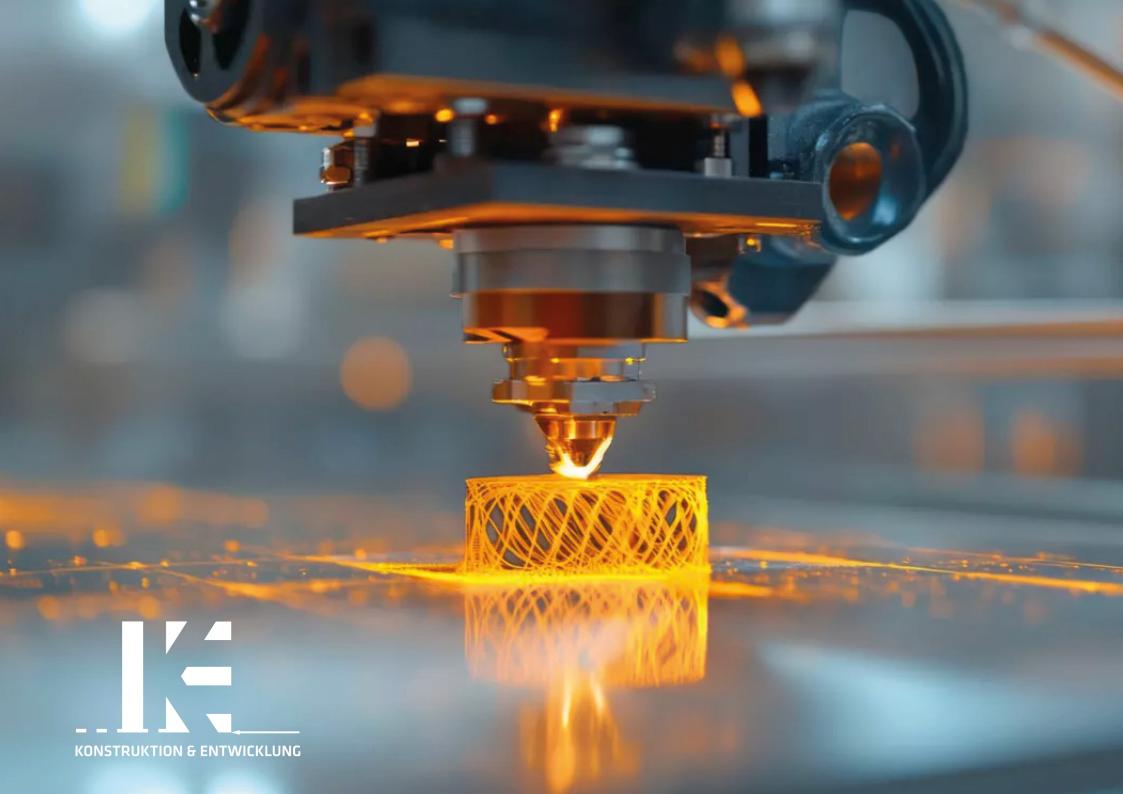

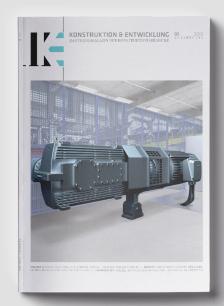

This project involved a complete redesign of an existing trade magazine (print run of approximately 25,000 copies) as well as the development of a new application for the tablet and smartphone market.

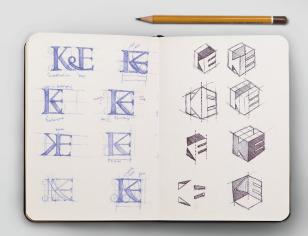
Starting from the wordmark and logo, through color palette, typography, and layout design, to a cohesive visual and illustration style for infographics, the existing elements were thoroughly analyzed and redefined.

The primary goal was to create a calmer, more sophisticated, and coherent user experience on the front end while significantly streamlining editorial workflows on the back end. This was achieved through intuitive templates and a clearly defined design manual. Engaging readers during the development phase played a key role in the targeted relaunch.

In close collaboration with partnership spokesperson Prof. Dr. Knut Möller and photographer Bernd Müller, an editorial design was developed that emphasizes core communication elements, delivering clear and factual information without unnecessary embellishments.

Drawing inspiration from the university's official typeface and the color palette of the parent brand, the design creates a professional and fact-driven presentation in both typography and infographics. Combined with the expressive visual imagery, it strikes a harmonious balance within the final concept.

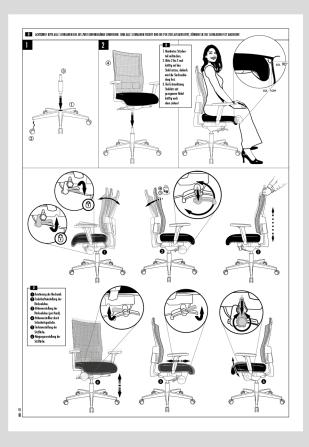

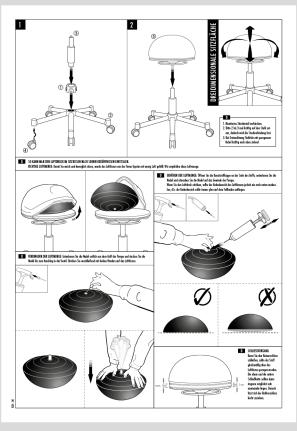

A streamlined, minimalist design concept has been successfully implemented for years in numerous assembly instructions. Given the challenge of including all required languages within the available layout space, each newly developed instruction is equipped with intuitive assembly illustrations to minimize the need for textual explanations.

Additional icons used in catalogs, on packaging, in digital media, and across all other company platforms ensure clear and effective communication, enabling a nearly universal understanding between manufacturer and consumer.

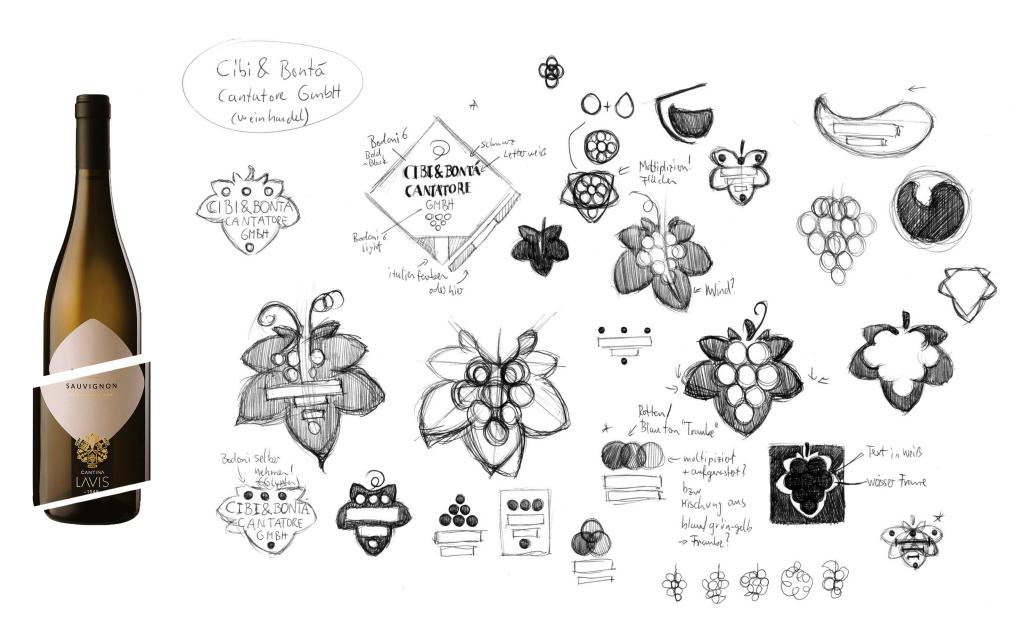

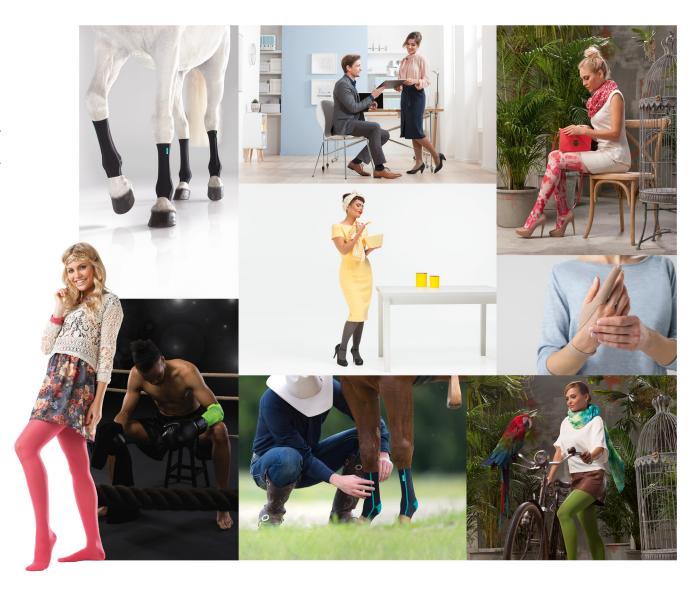

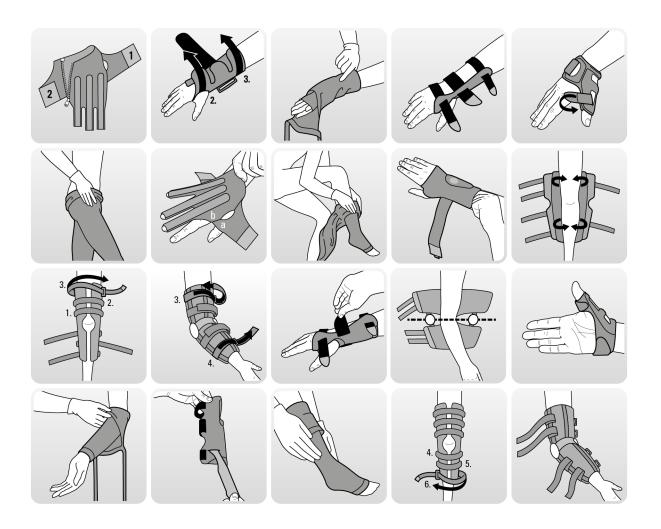

## **Augsburg Technical University**

In the computer game "e-transform," residents of a modern urban neighborhood experience the conflict between energy-conscious living and the demands of their personal and professional lives. This point-and-click adventure was developed using the Unity 5 engine.

In collaboration with the Interactive Media Research Department at the Augsburg University of Applied Sciences, led by Prof. Müller, a serious game was created. The characters in the game form an interconnected team, each contributing different perspectives on the energy transition based on their unique backgrounds, experiences, skills, and beliefs. Will the residents succeed in constructively advancing the vision of the neighborhood, or will they become entangled in their own contradictions? Can they find a way to live well together, or will the neighborhood devolve into a dystopian setting?

The storyline, crafted by playwright Volker Lüdecke, immerses the characters in numerous dilemmas, forcing them to make choices that carry significant consequences. These decisions create contingency, shaping the game's developments as the narrative unfolds. The characters become a subjective interface, a window into a complex scenario.
